The Swing Field Unit ETO offers you a journey into the nightlife of the 1940s. Night after night, civilians and soldiers alike are looking for distraction from the daily struggles, fights and fears of war. Swing music is the music of the time - and that is exactly what you get when you listen to the Swing Field Unit.

But the Swing Field Unit ETO is more than your average band - they are professional reenactors, displaying a group of musicians from the US 16th Infantry Regiment Band 1st Infantry Divison, performing with a female, civilian singer. Small combos like this with special orders are historically correct and could be found all around the European Theater of Operations (ETO). Many of them used to play for the recreation of the GIs just outside the combat zone and at special shows provided by the US Army and Army Air Corps. Many singers and bands from the US took part in those shows - the most famous of them was probably Marlene Dietrich.
